Green Tea Infusions

Green tea is very versatile and we have been able to provide a range of green teas, which have been blended with exotic and interesting ingredients such as cherries and other classic black teas to provide a wonderful range of exquisite tea.

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in 60–80°C water for 2–3 minutes.



Cherry Blossom Tea 20013

This is a delicious Japanese green tea which is blended with peony flower petals, rose petals and cherries to produce a beautifully balanced tea with a distinctive cherry undertone.



Green Mint 20020

This is a delightful and refreshing brew which combines the strength of China gunpowder tea with the direct sweetness and aroma of mint leaves, creating a well-balanced and stimulating tea which awakens all the senses.



Jasmine Bai Mao Huo 20018

Also known as 'White Haired Monkey' because the young tea buds appear twisted and have a silvery hue. The tea produces a classic, sweet, jasmine flavour and wonderful aroma. It was traditionally drunk by Chinese ladies for its beauty-enhancing qualities!

Fruit Infusions

Some of the classic dried fruits such as apple and orange have been blended with herbal teas or other complementary fruity ingredients such as lemon peel or rose hips.



Very Berry Tea 20029

This is a truly delicious and refreshing fruit infusion which contains a variety of dried fruit ingredients for all berry lovers.

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in boiling water for 5 minutes.

Black Tea Infusions

Some of our classic black teas from Ceylon, India and China have been blended with flowers, fruits and essential oils to provide a range of truly stunningly tasty teas.

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in boiling water for 2–3 minutes unless otherwise stated.



Chai 20005

A touch of the South East – this is an Indian black tea that has been infused with a range of traditional spices to produce a deliciously spicy and warming brew. It is often brewed in hot milk, known as Chai Latte, to produce a healthy and much more interesting alternative to coffee.

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in 60–80°C water for 2–3 minutes



Cinnamon Tea 20007

A lovely blended Chinese black tea has been infused with cinnamon pieces, producing a truly exotic and spicy flavour.



Earl Grey 20002

One of the most widely drunk teas in the world, this is a blend of Chinese black tea and essential oil of bergamot which provides that beautiful aroma and flowery citrus flavour.



Earl Grey Orange 20003

The classic Earl Grey with bergamot oil is rounded off by sweet oranges, which combine well to produce a soft, balanced black tea which is further enhanced with real, noble tea-tree blossoms.



Mango Tea 20010

A mild, spicy blend of Ceylon and Chinese tea is enriched with sweet, dried mango cubes and sunflower blossoms to produce a lovely exotic tea.



Rose Tea 20006

Rose petals are blended with black tea, creating a beautiful marriage of taste and texture. The rose petals add a wonderful, flowery sweetness to the black tea, making this a popular choice.



Vanilla Tea 20011

Vanilla tea is a high-grade blend of aromatic and spicy Assam and Ceylon teas which provide a lovely depth to the brew. This blend of teas is complemented with slightly spicy vanilla pieces which combine wonderfully to produce a very mellowing and enjoyable cup of tea.

White Tea Infusions

We have taken some of our white teas and have blended them with a range of different accompaniments such as oranges to create a bespoke range of teas.

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in 60–80°C water for 2–3 minutes.



White Apricot Tea 20021

A truly refreshing tea which combines white tea with apricot pieces, marigold flowers and yellow rose buds. The combination of sweet apricot with hints of marigold and rose creates a delightfully tasty white tea which can also be drunk as an iced tea.



White Essence Tea 20024

A truly exotic and delicious blend packed with goodness. White tea leaves are infused with a wonderful combination of floral and citrus notes produced by rose, orange peel and rose hips – a delicious tea!



White Harmony Tea 20023

This is a soothing and delicious tea, ideal for relaxed moments. White tea is infused with chamomile, rose and lavender to create a lightly floral aroma which sits on top of the distinctive mellow flavour of chamomile.



Classic Fusions

Green Teas

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in 60–70°C water for 2–3 minutes unless otherwise stated.



China Gunpowder 10012

Also known as the 'Temple of Heaven', the organically cultivated leaves take the form of bullets when rolled, and can be heard crackling during brewing! This tea has a unique taste with a strong and tangy aroma.



China White Hair 10013

This wonderful green tea is grown in high mountain tea estates where the gardens are covered by thick fog most of the year. This produces a superior quality tea which is mellow, smooth and delicate in character.

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in 60–80°C water for 2–3 minutes



Japan Sencha 10015

Sencha, which means 'steamed tea', is by far the most popular tea in Japan. It has a tender and sweetish note, which will appeal to everyone's taste!

Oolong Teas

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in 60–80°C water for 2–3 minutes.



China Oolong Tea 10020

China Oolong Tea has a delicious and distinctive flavour with vanilla undertones. This extraordinary tea is characterised by a milky and smooth infusion and is a true delight to all the senses.





Black Teas

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in boiling hot water for 2–3 minutes.



Afternoon Tea 10009

Also known as the 'High Noon' tea, it has a particularly lovely aromatic, flowery taste. This tea is blended with long leaves from Darjeeling and Ceylon and is ideal with scones and cakes.



Darjeeling First Flush 10005

Sometimes referred to as the 'champagne' of Indian teas because they are usually flowery, light and extremely aromatic. A good first flush tea develops a lively, fresh, aromatic character; sometimes with a hint of nutmeg. The infusion is generally bright yellow or honey in colour.



Assam Bargang 10002

Assam Bargang tea comes from an estate located on the north banks of the Brahmaputra river in the Sonipur district in Northern India. The leaves are broken, which helps to give it a strong and creamy infusion, which is perfect for those looking for a more powerful Assam brew.



Darjeeling Goomtee 10004

Goomtee is ranked among the top gardens in Darjeeling, India and produces luscious green leaves with hues ranging from oaky-brown to light green. This tea offers a deliciously smooth yet distinctive taste.



Ceylon Kenilworth 10003

A Sri Lankan tea estate was created in 1947 by an English pioneer who named it after the famous Kenilworth castle in Warwickshire, England. Ceylon Kenilworth produces a high quality, full-bodied infusion.



English Breakfast 10008

Our English Breakfast Tea is cultivated organically and is a blend of Assam and Sumatran teas which produces a lovely, dark infusion with a malty spiciness.

White Teas

Brewing: Brew one teaspoon per mug in 70–80°C water for 2–3 minutes.



China Pai Mu Tan 10017

Also known as 'White Peony', the organically cultivated tea leaves show many different shades of green and are fluffy with traces of longish, silvery-white leaf tips. This tea is one of the best known Chinese white teas because it has a wonderful spicy note producing a light brew and lovely amber infusion.
